## Litigator of the Week Runners-Up and Shout-Outs

NASCAR and its team at Latham & Watkins nosed back ahead in its back-and-forth litigation with two race teams seeking to compete this season as chartered teams without releasing their antitrust claim against the organization. The Fourth Circuit this week sided with NASCAR and lifted an injunction that had allowed Front Row Motorsports and 23XI Racing, the team co-owned by Michael Jordan and three-time Daytona 500 winner Denny Hamlin, to compete in February's edition of the iconic stock car race with chartered privileges. The Latham team includes Chris Yates, who argued the appeal; Larry Buterman, Anna Rathbun, Ashley Bauer and Greg Garre; counsel Rob McNary; and associates Christina Gay, David Johnson and Christopher Brown, with local counsel Tricia Wilson Magee of Shumaker, Loop & Kendrick.
