

Litigator of the Week Runners-Up and Shout-Outs

► Shout-out to appellate teams at Cahill Gordon & Reindel, representing Credit Suisse, and **Latham & Watkins**, representing KPMG, at the Second Circuit in a shareholder suit seeking to hold the bank, certain executives and its auditors accountable for its 2023 collapse. The appellate court this week upheld a lower court decision dismissing RICO claims with prejudice and breach of fiduciary claims on forum non conveniens grounds, finding the case belonged in Switzerland. The Cahill team representing Credit Suisse entities and several individual defendants included partners Herbert Washer, Jason Hall, Edward Moss and Tammy Roy, counsel Nicholas Matuschak and associate Britney Foerter. Hall argued the appeal for the Credit Suisse defendants. The **Latham** team for KPMG included partners **Jamie Wine**, **Jason Hegt** and **Stephen Barry**, counsel **Corey Calabrese** and associate **Scott Rothstein**. **Wine** argued the appeal for KPMG. Other individual KPMG defendants were represented by David Axelrod of Ballard Spahr, Antonio Yanez Jr. and Pia Williams Keevil of Willkie Farr and Natasha Ertzbischoff, Jonathan Richman and Stephen Cook of Brown Rudnick.
