■ **What was the biggest challenge you faced in the past year and how did you adjust to it?**

The new House of Representatives majority has significantly increased its activity, leading to an increase in the number of clients requiring advice about responses to Congressional inquiries or how to best position themselves in case those inquiries should arise. Our Congressional Investigations practice, led by newly returned partners Jonathan Su and Nick McQuaid helped ensure that we were prepared to provide that advice. –Kevin Chambers

■ **What is a significant case you have handled in the past year and how did it stand out?**

We represented former US Senator and Chairman of the Senate Intelligence Committee Richard Burr (R-NC) in the Department of Justice and Securities and Exchange Commission investigations into the former Senator's sale of certain stocks during the COVID-19 pandemic. In January 2021, the DOJ closed its investigation of the Senator without action, and in January 2023, the SEC did the same. –Doug Yatter
